Alison, Kerri, Helen and Caroline wanted to know what people had missed during lockdown and were looking forward to doing at the end of it. They

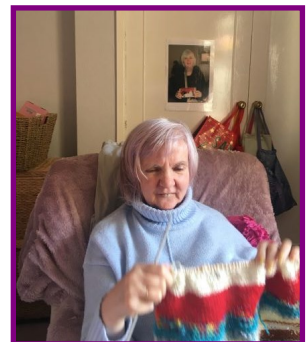
asked people the questions, wrote the answers on bright card and stuck them to the wall to make a very colourful display of care and hope.



Keeping Busy

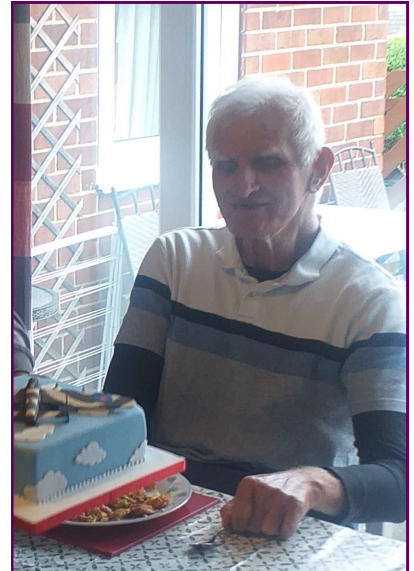


Carolyn and Christine have been keeping busy making bread, drawing, knitting and having fun in the garden with bubbles!

David has taken a special interest in feeding the birds in the garden of his home over the last few months. Here he is making sure that they have food for the day

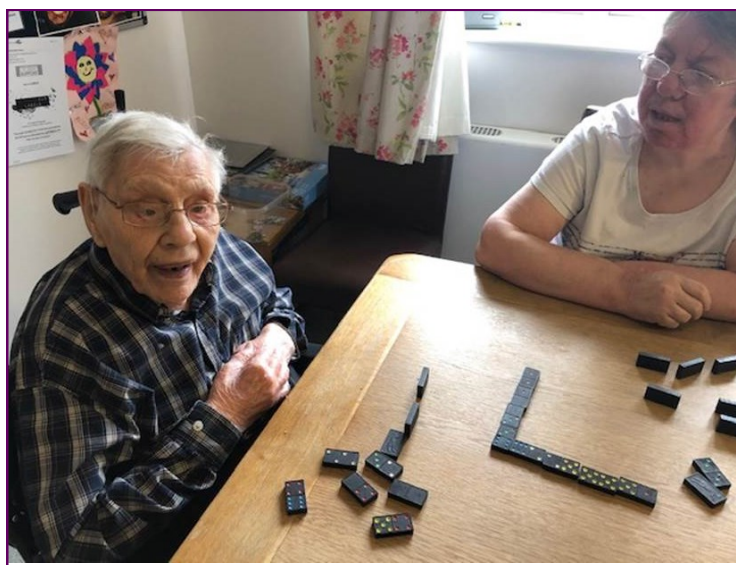


Movie Day
