Places that you visit


Places that you go to for appointments

You need to tell someone that you trust:

- Social Worker or Care Manager

You can be supported to contact the police, or to make an urgent referral through the local authority's Safeguarding Adults Procedure.

To report concerns regarding your safety or the safety or others, you can contact:

- Any member of Creative Support staff or if you prefer you can ring Head Office on 0161 236 0829.
- The local authority safeguarding team (staff can help get this information for you)
- Police—101 if it is not an emergency or 999 if it is an emergency
