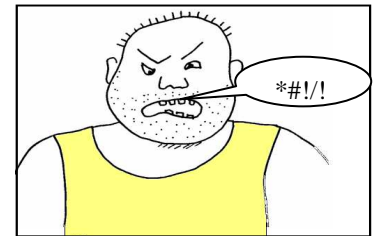
You have a right to be protected

Abuse could be:

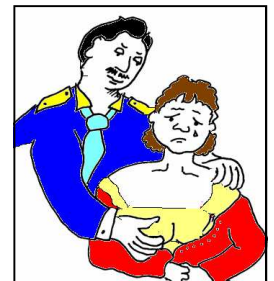
- Hitting, slapping, pushing



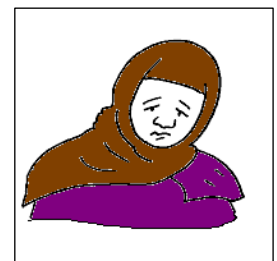
- Shouting or swearing

- It can happen in lots of different places:

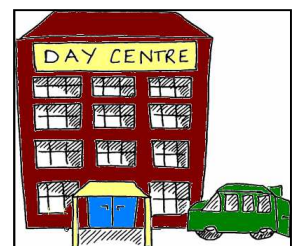
- In the house



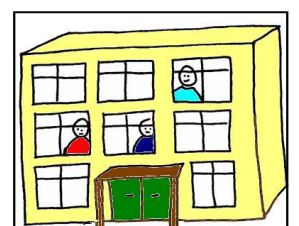
- On the street



- Places that you visit



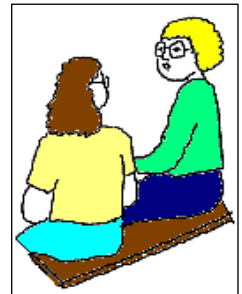
- Places that you go to for appointments

- Social Worker or Care Manager



- Police



You can be supported to contact the police, or to make an urgent referral through the local authority's Safeguarding Adults Procedure.

To report concerns regarding your safety or the safety of others, you can contact:

- The local authority safeguarding team (staff can help get this information for you)
- Police—101 if it is not an emergency or 999 if it is an emergency
