




# Get Ready to Vote!

Register by Monday 20th April

Local elections are coming up on **Thursday 7th May**, and we want to encourage our staff and the people we support to have their say and vote to elect their local MP.



To vote in the Local Election, you must be **registered to vote** and have a **valid ID**.



The voter registration deadline for the Local Election is **Monday 20th April**. You can register to vote by visiting:

You will need a form of ID when you vote. If you don't have a photo ID, you can apply for a Voter Authority Certificate which you can bring to the polling station.

**If you cannot vote in person there are other ways to vote:**



**Apply for a postal vote by:**  
5pm on Tuesday 21st April



**Apply for a proxy vote by:**  
5pm on Tuesday 28th April

If you can't vote in person, a proxy vote allows someone to vote on your behalf, or you can send off your vote by post.
